Medicare's Basic Benefit:

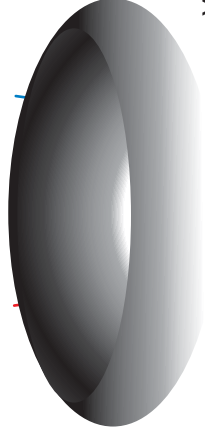
Besides the annual premium, you pay . . .



\$295 Annual Deductible
(You pay 100%)

After the deductible, you pay about 25% of the cost of each prescription until \$2,700 in drug costs (about \$675)

You reach the \$2,700 drug coverage limit - you're headed for the Doughnut Hole



Drug costs of \$2,701 to \$6,154
You pay 100% out of pocket

You can afford the out-of-pocket drug costs, so you can work your way out of the doughnut hole.



You can't afford your drugs and must choose between health, home, and family. You are stuck in the doughnut hole.
